



Clovis Area IDAC Meeting November 18, 2019

1. Welcome - Dr. Scott Dille (5 minutes)
 - a. IDAC Goals – Dr. Dille went over how one of the goals of IDAC is to bring character and diversity education to our students.
 - b. The Positivity Project – He then explained how our K-8 schools are using the Positivity Project to do this...and gave an overview of the program. He invited students from 2 of our schools to share how they use and what they learn from their experience since starting this program.
2. Sierra Vista Elementary – student presentation (20 minutes) students and staff from SV shared their experiences and led the audience in an activity on the affects of bullying.
3. Clovis Elementary – student presentation (20 minutes) similarly, students and staff from CE shared their experiences and they led the audience in an activity on how to give positive compliments to others to build them up.
4. Browder Files Update – Mrs. Demetra Vincent-Walker (5 minutes) – Mrs. Walker shared the success of last years program and the plans for this coming January for year 2. This year they will have another group of “year 1” students starting but will also add sessions for “year 2” students who completed last years program.
5. Character Strong Update – Clovis High School (15 minutes) – Students from Clovis High School shared on how the character education program “Character Strong” or as they call it, “Cougar Strong” program is working. As part of this, the gave examples of how the Family Group time at CHS is incorporating lessons from this program to help students grow and appreciate the diversity around them.
