- Web- and App-based system that speeds internal communication to respond and investigate safety concerns
- Allows faster response time to execute lockdowns, evacuations, and other safety responses
- Quicker accounting of students' whereabouts on campus in the event of an emergency
- Involves site safety teams and district support to speed parent communication

Alerts that teachers and students hear from cell phones and smart watches

Communication capabilities- including Site Safety Plan maps

Student/Sibling	School Attendance	Accommodations
TK through 4th Grade Student must be in grades TK-4 th during 2025-26 school year.	Must attend New School. Except for Eligible sibling of a 5 th or 6 th grader who has a Boundary Exception.	None
5th and 6th Grade Student must be in 5 th or 6 th grade during 2025-26 school year.	May attend either the original school or the new student for 5 th and 6 th grade.	Declaration of Attendance required from ALL 5 th and 6 th graders to declare where they will attend. Once turned in and processed, they will have a "Boundary Exception." Must be turned in between October 7, 2024, and October 24, 2024.
Younger Sibling of 5th and 6th Grader Student must be a younger sibling of a 5 th or 6 th grader who has been granted a Boundary Exception.	May attend the original school with a 5 th or 6 th grade sibling who was granted a Boundary Exception. Once the 5 th or 6 th grader re-enrolls to 7 th grade, the younger sibling will attend the newly assigned school.	Priority Intradistrict Transfer Must be turned in between October 7, 2024, and October 24, 2024.

- Revisited Facilities Audit and Master Plan identifying extensive needs to maintain quality facilities for ALL students
