- Allows faster response time to execute lockdowns, evacuations, and other safety responses
- Quicker accounting of students' whereabouts on campus in the event of an emergency
- Involves site safety teams and district support to speed parent communication



On November 4 Ballot for Voters

Extends but doesn't increase existing tax

- · Lower than neighbor districts
- . Lowest in district's history

- · All 2020 bond funds are spent or committed
